Measure (Community Ready): 100% of our students graduate with a plan



"ALL IN" Four Central Beliefs (Horsford, 2014, ch. 3, p.52)

- 1. That all children (except only a very small percentage, e.g., those with pro-found disabilities) are capable of high levels of academic success.
- 2. That all means all, regardless of a child's race, social class, gender, sexual orientation, learning differences, culture, language, religion, and so on.
- 3. That the adults in schools are primarily responsible for student learning.
- 4. That traditional school practices may work for some students but are not working for all children. Therefore, if we are going to eliminate the achievement gap, it requires a change in our practices (Sklra, McKenzie, & Scheurich, 2009, pp. 82-83).
