

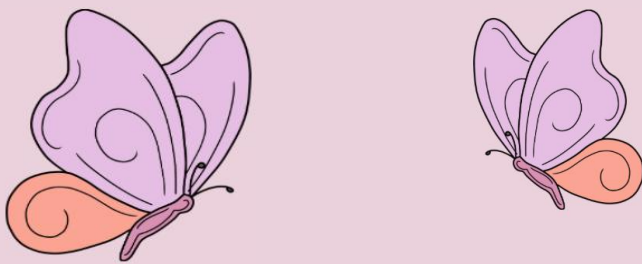
Actor Of The Month! By: Amira Moore
