Expected Bus Behaviors:

Listening & following driver's directions; walking on and walking off the bus without pushing/shoving; immediately sitting in your seat; always staying in your seat, facing forward with your backpack on your lap; using level one, classroom voices; always using positive words to treat others with respect; always putting garbage in the trash can at the door when you are exiting the bus

Incentives & Rewards:

Praise; smiles; positive statements to student; Vikes tickets; special seat privileges; happy notes to teacher or home; playing special music on bus CD player; piece of candy upon exiting bus

Step 1	Stop &Think prompt; non-verbal prompt (increase/decrease radio volume); group warning over PA; move student to another seat		
Sten 2	Verbal Warning - driver pulls student aside at driver seat to discuss his/her behavior and remind him/her of appropriate behavior on the bus & share consequences for continued poor choices		
Step 3	Written Referral (see chart below)
